LICENCE to engage in Mail Handling Services:

The Post Office Act 1900 as amended by the Post Office Amendment Act 1991 requires any person performing mail handling services to apply to the Minister of Finance for a license to do so.

WHEREAS the person named in the Schedule hereto has applied to the Minister of Finance to engage in the collection and distribution of mail; now therefore in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by Section 6A of the Post Office Act, 1900. All other powers in that behalf enabling him the Minister of Finance hereby grants to the person licensee and permission to engage in such services aforesaid subject to the conditions hereinafter set forth.

The Conditions above Referred to

1. Letters, not being express letters, collected in Bermuda for delivery in Bermuda, shall be conveyed to the Post Office for delivery to the addressees.
2. Letter, not being express letters, collected outside of Bermuda for delivery in Bermuda shall be conveyed to the Post Office for delivery to the addressee.
3. Letters conveyed to the Post Office shall be sorted to Post Office specifications.
4. The Licensee agrees to abide by any changes in operational procedures that may be instituted by the Post Office with respect to the handling of mail, as the need arises.
5. The Licensee shall pay on _____ the annual license fee as set out in the Government Fees Regulations; and if he fails to pay the annual license fee on or before the stipulated date, the license automatically ceases to be in force.
6. The licensee gives his consent for any authorized officer of the Post Office to inspect the business premises of the licensee at anytime during normal business hours and to inspect at the port of entry all mail arriving in Bermuda for the licensee.

7. The licensee shall not by advertisement or any other form of communication, purport to be an agent of the Post Office; nor shall he operate in such a manner as to reasonable lead the public to believe that he is an agent of the Post Office.
8. The licensee shall not operate in any manner, which may diminish the good reputation of the postal service in Bermuda.
9. The licensee shall inform the Post Office, within seven days, prior to any change in normal business hours.
10. The licensee shall not contravene the Post Office Act 1900. If a licensee on conviction of an offence against the Post Office Act 1900 is liable to a fine of more than one hundred and fifty dollars or is liable to imprisonment, the license automatically ceases to be in force.
11. This license is not transferable.
